2 relating to the composition of the Eighth and Eleventh courts of
3 appeals districts.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Sections 22.201(i) and (l), Government Code, are
6 amended to read as follows:

7 (i) The Eighth Court of Appeals District is composed of the
8 counties of Andrews, Brewster, Crane, Crockett, Culberson,
9 [~~Ector~~] El Paso, [~~Gaines, Glasscock~~] Hudspeth, Jeff Davis,
10 Loving, [~~Martin, Midland~~] Pecos, Presidio, Reagan, Reeves,
11 Terrell, Upton, Ward, and Winkler.

12 (l) The Eleventh Court of Appeals District is composed of
13 the counties of Baylor, Borden, Brown, Callahan, Coleman, Comanche,
14 Dawson, Eastland, Ector, Erath, Fisher, Gaines, Glasscock,
15 Haskell, Howard, Jones, Knox, Martin, Midland, Mitchell, Nolan,
16 Palo Pinto, Scurry, Shackelford, Stephens, Stonewall, Taylor, and
17 Throckmorton.

18 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect the jurisdiction on
19 appeal of any case from a county that is transferred by this Act to a
20 different court of appeals district if the transcripts for the case
21 were filed before the effective date of this Act in the appropriate
22 court of appeals district.

23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
