## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT

- 2 relating to the authority of certain state agencies to purchase
- 3 prescription drugs and other medications jointly with other states.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 531, Government Code, is 6 amended by adding Section 531.063 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 531.063. JOINT PURCHASING OF PRESCRIPTION DRUGS AND
- 8 OTHER MEDICATIONS. (a) Notwithstanding any other law, the
- 9 commission and each health and human services agency authorized by
- 10 the commission may enter into an agreement with one or more other
- 11 states for the joint bulk purchasing of prescription drugs and
- other medications to be used in the Medicaid program or another
- 13 government-funded health program in this state.
- 14 (b) The commission shall adopt procedures applicable to an
- 15 agreement and joint purchase authorized by this section. The
- 16 procedures must ensure that this state receives:
- 17 (1) all prescription drugs and other medications
- 18 purchased with money provided by this state; and
- 19 (2) an equitable share of any price benefits resulting
- 20 <u>from the joint bulk purchase.</u>
- 21 SECTION 2. If before implementing any provision of this Act
- 22 a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a
- 23 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,
- 24 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or

- 1 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the
- 2 waiver or authorization is granted.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
