4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 408, Labor Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 408.009 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 408.009. EFFECT OF RECEIPT OF SOCIAL SECURITY
8	DISABILITY BENEFITS BY INJURED EMPLOYEE. (a) This section applies
9	only to an injured employee who is receiving social security
10	disability insurance benefits due to an injury compensable under
11	this subtitle.
12	(b) For purposes of the eligibility of an employee described
13	by Subsection (a) for benefits under this subtitle, in a dispute
14	regarding the impairment or attainment of maximum medical
15	improvement of the employee the commission shall consider the fact
16	that the employee remains eligible for the social security
17	disability insurance benefits as determinative of the fact that the
18	employee continues to be impaired as a result of the injury.
19	SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies to a

claim for workers' compensation benefits based on a compensable injury regardless of whether the injury occurs before, on, or after the effective date of this Act.

23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

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provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2003.

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
