4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 410.252, Labor Code, is amended by

adding Subsections (c) and (d) to read as follows:

- 7 (c) If a suit under this section is filed in a county other
- 8 than the county described by Subsection (b), the court, on
- 9 determining that it does not have jurisdiction to render judgment
- on the merits of the suit, shall transfer the case to a proper court
- in a county described by Subsection (b). Notice of the transfer of
- 12 <u>a suit shall be given to the parties</u>. A suit transferred under this
- 13 subsection shall be considered for all purposes the same as if
- originally filed in the court to which it is transferred.
- 15 (d) If a suit is initially filed within the 40-day period in
- 16 Subsection (a), and is transferred under Subsection (c), the suit
- 17 is considered to be timely filed in the court to which it is
- 18 <u>transferred</u>.
- 19 SECTION 2. Section 410.252, Labor Code, as amended by this
- 20 Act, applies only to a cause of action that accrues on or after the
- 21 effective date of this Act. A cause of action that accrues before
- that date is governed by the law as it existed immediately before
- 23 the effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect
- 24 for that purpose.
