- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

- Sec. 161.0411. DOMESTIC AND EXOTIC FOWL REGISTRATION. (a)

 8 A seller, distributor, or transporter of live domestic or exotic

 9 fowl in this state shall register with the commission under this

 10 section. This section does not apply to a person participating in

disease surveillance programs as recognized by the commission.

 13 or a renewal of a certificate of registration under this section by

 14 submitting an application and an annual fee prescribed by the

 15 commission. A person must complete an application for a

- 8 <u>(g) An offense under this section is a Class C misdemeanor</u>
- 9 unless it is shown on the trial of the offense that the defendant
- 10 has been previously convicted under this section, in which event
- 11 the offense is a Class B misdemeanor.
- 12 SECTION 2. Not later than January 1, 2004, the Texas Animal
- 13 Health Commission shall adopt rules to administer Section 161.0411,
- 14 Agriculture Code, as added by this Act.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003, except
- that Sections 161.0411(a), (f), and (g), Agriculture Code, as added
- 17 by this Act, take effect February 1, 2004.
