1 (3) promptly respond to a request made by a customer, a 2 customer's selected retail electric provider, or the independent system operator for information regarding the customer's request to 3 4 change the customer's retail electric provider. 5 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2003. 9
