1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to the duties of the district attorney in Washington and  
1-9 Burleson counties.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Section 43.108, Government Code, is amended to  
1-12 read as follows:

1-13 Sec. 43.108. 21ST JUDICIAL DISTRICT. (a) The voters of  
1-14 Washington and Burleson counties elect a district attorney for the  
1-15 21st Judicial District who represents the state in that district  
1-16 court only in those counties.

1-17 (b) The district attorney also represents the state and  
1-18 performs the duties of district attorney before the 335th District  
1-19 Court in Washington and Burleson counties.

1-20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
1-21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
1-22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
1-23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
1-24 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
