| 15 | (b) The board shall prepare an impact statement for each            |

| 17 | the bill or resolution is referred to a committee in either house.  |
| 18 | (c) The impact statement must estimate the costs of each            |
| 19 | mandate included in the bill or resolution to school districts as   |
