1-6 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to the dissolution of the Southeast Trinity Groundwater
1-9 Conservation District.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. The Southeast Trinity Groundwater Conservation
1-12 District, as created by Chapter 1331, Acts of the 76th Legislature,
1-13 Regular Session, 1999, and the creation of which was ratified by
1-14 Part 10, Article 3, Chapter 966, Acts of the 77th Legislature,
1-15 Regular Session, 2001, and Chapter 1335, Acts of the 77th
1-16 Legislature, Regular Session, 2001, is dissolved, except that:

1-17 (1) all debts incurred by the district shall be paid;

1-18 (2) any assets that remain after payment of the debts
1-19 shall be transferred to Comal County; and

1-20 (3) the organization of the district shall be
1-21 maintained until all debts are paid and the remaining assets are
1-22 transferred.

1-23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-25 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-26 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-27 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
