- 7 Sec. 143.1055. MINIMUM STAFFING FOR FIRE APPARATUS. (a) In
- 8 this section:
- 9 (1) "Engine company" means a fire company whose
- 10 primary functions are to pump and deliver water and to perform fire
- 11 suppression and maintenance.
- 12 (2) "Ladder or truck company" means a fire company
- 13 whose primary functions are to perform services associated with
- 14 truck work, including forcible entry, ventilation, search and
- 15 rescue, aerial operations, utility control, illumination,
- 16 overhaul, and salvage work.
- (b) Except as provided by Subsection (c), an engine company
- or a ladder or truck company shall be staffed with at least four
- 19 on-duty fire fighters.
- (c) If a fire company serves an area that the fire
- 21 department determines is a high risk area because of tactical
- 22 hazards, high hazard occupancies, high incident frequencies,
- 23 geographical restrictions, or other relevant factors, the fire
- company shall be staffed with at least:

- 1 (1) five on-duty fire fighters if the company is an
- 2 engine company; or
- 3 (2) six on-duty fire fighters if the company is a
- 4 ladder or truck company.
- 5 (d) Each fire company shall be led by an officer who is
- 6 considered a fire fighter of the company for purposes of
- 7 Subsections (b) and (c).
- 8 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
