1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to the frequency of inspection and testing of weights and
1-9 measures.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Section 13.101(a), Agriculture Code, is amended
1-12 to read as follows:

1-13 (a) At least once every four [~~three~~] years, or more often as
1-14 required by the department, a weight or measure shall be inspected
1-15 and tested for correctness by a sealer if it:

1-16 (1) is kept for sale, sold, or used by a proprietor,
1-17 agent, lessee, or employee in proving the weight or measure,
1-18 including the size, quantity, extent, or area, of any item; or

1-19 (2) is purchased, offered, or submitted by a
1-20 proprietor, agent, lessee, or employee for sale, hire, or award.

1-21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
