A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

1
2 relating to the issuance of special license plates to benefit the
3 Texas 4-H and Youth Development Program.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Subchapter F, Chapter 502, Transportation Code,
6 is amended by adding Section 502.2934 to read as follows:

7 Sec. 502.2934. 4-H LICENSE PLATES. (a) The department
8 shall issue specially designed "4-H" license plates for each type
9 of vehicle subject to registration under this chapter.

10 (b) The license plates must include the words "To Make the
11 Best Better," "Texas 4-H," and the 4-H symbol of the four leaf
12 clover.

13 (c) The department shall design the license plate in
14 consultation with the Texas 4-H and Youth Development Program. The
15 department may vary the design according to the type of vehicle for
16 which the license plates are issued.

17 (d) The department shall issue license plates under this
18 section to a person who:

19 (1) applies to the assessor-collector of the county in
20 which the person resides on a form provided by the department; and

21 (2) pays an annual fee of \$30, in addition to any
22 applicable fee prescribed by Subchapter D and, if personalized
23 prestige license plates are issued, in addition to the fee
24 prescribed by Section 502.251.

1 (e) Of each fee collected under this section:

2 (1) \$8 shall be deposited to the credit of the state
3 highway fund to defray the cost of administering this section;

4 (2) 50 cents shall be deposited by the county
5 treasurer of the county in which the applicant resides to the credit
6 of the general fund of the county to pay the costs of administering
7 this section; and

8 (3) the remainder shall be deposited to the credit of
9 the general revenue fund and used only by the Texas Cooperative
10 Extension of The Texas A&M University System for 4-H and Youth
11 Development Programs and to support the Texas Cooperative
12 Extension's activities related to 4-H and Youth Development
13 Programs.

14 (f) If license plates issued under this section are lost,
15 stolen, or mutilated, the owner of the vehicle for which the license
16 plates were issued may obtain replacement plates from the
17 department by paying the fee prescribed by Section 502.184(a)(2).

18 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
