1-13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-14 SECTION 1. Effective September 1, 2003, Section 32.043(a),
1-15 Government Code, is amended to read as follows:

1-16 (a) Notwithstanding Section 659.012, the [The]
1-17 Commissioners Court of Collin County may budget for and pay the
1-18 judges of the district courts having jurisdiction in the county an
1-19 annual salary set by the commissioners court for services rendered
1-20 and for performing administrative services.

1-21 SECTION 2. Effective September 1, 2007, Section 32.043(a),
1-22 Government Code, is reenacted to read as follows:

1-23 (a) The Commissioners Court of Collin County may budget for
1-24 and pay the judges of the district courts having jurisdiction in the
1-25 county an annual salary set by the commissioners court for services
1-26 rendered and for performing administrative services.

1-27 SECTION 3. Effective September 1, 2003, Section 32.227(a),
1-28 Government Code, is amended to read as follows:

1-29 (a) Notwithstanding Section 659.012, the [The]
1-30 Commissioners Court of Travis County may pay the judges of the
1-31 district courts having jurisdiction in the county an annual salary
1-32 in an amount set by the commissioners court for services rendered
1-33 and for performing administrative duties.

1-34 SECTION 4. Effective September 1, 2007, Section 32.227(a),
1-35 Government Code, is reenacted to read as follows:

1-36 (a) The Commissioners Court of Travis County may pay the
1-37 judges of the district courts having jurisdiction in the county an
1-38 annual salary in an amount set by the commissioners court for
1-39 services rendered and for performing administrative duties.

1-40 SECTION 5. Sections 32.043(d) and 32.227(c), Government
1-41 Code, are repealed.

1-42 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
