5	SECTION 1. Section 20.06, Business & Commerce Code, is
6	amended by adding Subsection (h) to read as follows:
7	(h) This section applies to a business offering check
8	verification or check guarantee services in this state.
9	SECTION 2. Chapter 20, Business & Commerce Code, is amended
10	by adding Section 20.11 to read as follows:
11	Sec. 20.11. CHECK VERIFICATION AND CHECK GUARANTEE
12	SERVICES; DISCLOSURES TO CONSUMERS. (a) In this section, "check
13	verifier" means any business offering check verification or check
14	guarantee services in this state.
15	(b) On request and proper identification provided by a
16	consumer, a check verifier shall disclose to the consumer ir
17	writing all information pertaining to the consumer in the check
18	verifier's files at the time of the request, including:
19	(1) the criteria used by the check verifier to reject a
20	check from the consumer;

(3) a toll-free number at which personnel are

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- 1 available to consumers during normal business hours for use in
- 2 resolving a dispute if the consumer submits a written dispute to the
- 3 <u>check verifier.</u>
- 4 (c) A check verifier may not charge a consumer for
- 5 disclosing the information required under Subsection (b) if the
- 6 check verifier has rejected a check from the consumer in the 30 days
- 7 prior to the consumer's request for information. A check verifier
- 8 may otherwise impose a reasonable charge on a consumer for the
- 9 disclosure of information pertaining to the consumer in an amount
- not to exceed \$8.
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
