 16 <u>consumer, a check verifier shall disclose to the consumer in</u>
 17 <u>writing all information pertaining to the consumer in the check</u>
 18 <u>verifier's files at the time of the request, including:</u>
- 19 <u>(1) the criteria used by the check verifier to reject a</u> 20 check from the consumer;
- (2) a set of instructions describing how information
 is presented on the check verifier's written disclosure of the
 consumer file; and

- 1 available to consumers during normal business hours for use in
- 2 resolving a dispute if the consumer submits a written dispute to the
- 3 <u>check verifier.</u>
- 4 (c) A check verifier may not charge a consumer for
- 5 disclosing the information required under Subsection (b) if the
- 6 check verifier has rejected a check from the consumer in the 30 days
- 7 prior to the consumer's request for information. A check verifier
- 8 may otherwise impose a reasonable charge on a consumer for the
- 9 disclosure of information pertaining to the consumer in an amount
- not to exceed \$8.
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
