4	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 247, Health and Safety
5	Code, is amended by adding Section 247.032 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 247.032. REGISTRATION OF CERTAIN FACILITIES. (a) The
7	board by rule shall establish a classification and registration for
8	a facility that:
9	(1) furnishes food and shelter to three or fewer
10	persons who are unrelated to the proprietor of the facility; and
11	(2) provides personal care services.
12	(b) A person may not operate a facility described by
13	Subsection (a) unless the person is registered with the department
14	as provided by this section and board rule.
15	(c) A person may apply for registration under this section
16	by submitting:
17	(1) an application for registration on a form
18	prescribed by the board; and
19	(2) a fee of \$50.
20	(d) A registration is valid until the second anniversary of
21	the date of issuance.
22	(e) As provided by board rule, a facility registered under
23	this section is subject to inspection and monitoring by the

department.

- 4 (g) A person who violates this section is subject to the
- 5 penalties provided in Subchapter C.
- 6 SECTION 2. (a) Not later than January 1, 2004, the Texas
- 7 Board of Human Services shall adopt the rules necessary to
- 8 implement Section 247.032, Health and Safety Code, as added by this
- 9 Act.
- 10 (b) Notwithstanding Section 247.032, Health and Safety
- 11 Code, as added by this Act, a facility is not required to register
- with the Texas Department of Human Services before March 1, 2004.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
