4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 247.030(b), Health and Safety Code, is

amended to read as follows:

- 7 (b) The board shall adopt minimum standards for an assisted
- 8 living facility classified under this section, including standards
- 9 imposing adequate requirements relating to medication supervision.
- 10 The board shall modify accessibility and life safety code standards
- 11 generally applicable to a facility licensed under this chapter as
- 12 necessary for a facility classified under this section to reflect
- 13 the level of services provided by the facility. The modified
- 14 standards must be specifically defined by the board and must
- provide for two-story buildings. Two-story buildings must meet all
- 16 life safety code requirements in regards to protecting vertical
- 17 openings, as specified in the 1988 edition of the National Fire
- 18 Protection Association (NFPA) 101, Section 21-2.3.1. Type A and
- 19 Type B assisted living facilities, as classified by the board, must
- 20 conform to Chapter 21 of the 1988 edition of the National Fire
- 21 Protection Association (NFPA) 101.
- 22 SECTION 2. An assisted living facility is not required to
- comply with Section 247.030(b), Health and Safety Code, as amended
- 24 by this Act, before September 1, 2004.
