Section 111.044, Local Government Code, 11 is 12 amended to read as follows: Sec. 111.044. LIMITATION ON BUDGET OF COUNTY AUDITOR. 13 An 14 increase from one fiscal year to the next in the amount budgeted for expenses of the county auditor's office [or the salary of an 15 assistant auditor] shall not exceed five (5) percent without 16 approval of the commissioners court. 17 SECTION 3. Section 111.074, Local Government Code, 18 is amended to read as follows: 19 Sec. 111.074. LIMITATION ON BUDGET OF COUNTY AUDITOR. 20 An 21 increase from one fiscal year to the next in the amount budgeted for 22 expenses of the county auditor's office [or the salary of an assistant auditor] shall not exceed five (5) percent without 23 24 approval of the commissioners court.

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1 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect July 1, 2003, if it 2 receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each 3 house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. 4 If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for effect on that 5 date, this Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
