- 6 SECTION 1.01. STATE BOARD FOR EDUCATOR CERTIFICATION.
- 7 Section 21.035, Education Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 21.035. APPLICATION OF SUNSET ACT. (a) The board is
- 9 subject to Chapter 325, Government Code (Texas Sunset Act). Unless
- 10 continued in existence as provided by that chapter, the board is
- abolished and this subchapter expires September 1, 2005 [2003].
- 12 (b) The board and the Texas Education Agency shall enter
- 13 <u>into a memorandum of understanding to consolidate administrative</u>
- 14 functions and services.
- 15 (c) The sunset commission shall focus its review of the

- 17 commission to the 78th Legislature and compliance with the MOU to

- 19 SECTION 1.02. WINDHAM SCHOOL DISTRICT WITHIN TEXAS
