BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 1-15 SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 54, Education Code, is amended by adding Section 54.5392 to read as follows: 1-16 Sec. 54.5392. INTERCOLLEGIATE ATHLETICS FEE; 1-17 TEXAS <u>A&M</u> 1**-**18 1**-**19 UNIVERSITY--KINGSVILLE. (a) The board of regents of The Texas A&M University System may impose an intercollegiate athletics fee on 1-20 each student enrolled at Texas A&M University--Kingsville. The fee 1-21 may not be imposed unless approved by a majority vote of the students participating in a general student election held at the 1-22 university for that purpose.
