9	admit any person with mental retardation for whom an application

13	(2) the person is eligible to receive Medicaid

15	(3) the state school would provide the least

1 (d) The board may adopt rules to facilitate the application 2 process for voluntary admission to a state school, the maintenance 3 of the waiting list required by Subsection (b), and the provision of 4 information as required by Subsection (c).

5 SECTION 2. The Texas Department of Mental Health and Mental 6 Retardation shall ensure that persons on a waiting list maintained 7 by a mental retardation authority for admission to a state school 8 are informed of:

9 (1) criteria established in rules adopted under
10 Section 593.0225, Health and Safety Code, as added by this Act;

(2) the waiting lists required by that section; and

12 (3) the address and telephone number of each state 13 school.

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003, and applies to an application for voluntary admission filed on or after that date. An application for voluntary admission filed before that date is governed by the law in effect on the date the application was filed, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
