- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 724.048(c), Transportation Code, is
- 7 amended to read as follows:
- 8 (c) If a criminal charge arising from the same arrest as a
- 9 suspension under this chapter is dismissed or results in an
- 10 acquittal, the suspension under this chapter may not be imposed. If
- 11 a suspension under this chapter has already been imposed, the
- 12 department shall rescind the suspension and remove references to
- 13 the suspension from the computerized driving record of the
- 14 individual.
- 15 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
