## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to mandatory venue in actions against certain political
- 3 subdivisions.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 15.0151(a), Civil Practice and Remedies
- 6 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) Except as provided by a law not contained in this
- 8 chapter, an action against a political subdivision [that is located
- 9 in a county with a population of 100,000 or less] shall be brought
- in the county in which the political subdivision is located. If the
- 11 political subdivision is located in more than one county [and the
- 12 population of each county is 100,000 or less], the action shall be
- 13 brought in any county in which the political subdivision is
- 14 located.
- 15 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 16 to an action filed on or after the effective date of this Act. An
- 17 action filed before the effective date of this Act is governed by
- 18 the law in effect immediately before that date, and that law is
- 19 continued in effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
