5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Section 6(a), Chapter 307, Acts of the 61st

7 Legislature, Regular Session, 1969, is amended to read as follows:

8 (a) Contracts for the making and construction of all

improvements contemplated by this Act, and all necessary work in

connection therewith, or for the purchase of any machinery,

materials or supplies for the district, when the cost price exceeds

12 $$15,000 \left[\frac{$2,000}{} \right]$, shall be let to the lowest responsible bidder,

furnishing satisfactory evidence of possessing equipment and

14 facilities essential to the proper performance of such contract;

15 after giving notice by advertising the same in one or more

newspapers of general circulation in Brazoria County, Texas, one

time not less than 14 days prior to the opening of sealed bids. Such

contract shall be in writing and signed by the contractors and the

commissioners, and a copy of such contract so executed shall be

20 filed in the office of the district subject to inspection of all

21 interested parties.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003, and

23 applies only to a contract for which the notice advertising for bids

24 is published on or after that date.
