(a) <u>With respect to the operation of</u> <u>a campus or program granted a charter under this subchapter, the</u> [A] governing body of the campus or program provided for under the charter is considered a governmental body for purposes of Chapters 551 and 552, Government Code.
- (b) An employee of a campus or program granted a charter under <u>Section 12.052 or 12.053</u> [this subchapter] who qualifies for membership in the Teacher Retirement System of Texas shall be covered under the system in the same manner and to the same extent as a qualified employee employed on a regularly operating campus or in a regularly operating program is covered.
- (c) <u>A</u> [The] campus or program <u>granted a charter under</u> <u>Section 12.052 or 12.053</u> is immune from liability to the same extent as a school district, and its employees and volunteers are immune from liability to the same extent as school district employees and volunteers.
