4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 378, Local Government Code, as added by
6	Chapter 1221, Acts of the 76th Legislature, Regular Session, 1999,
7	is amended by adding Section 378.0045 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 378.0045. EMINENT DOMAIN. (a) An authority may
9	exercise the power of eminent domain to acquire property in or
10	adjacent to the base property only in the manner provided by Chapter
11	21, Property Code.
12	(b) Before the authority initiates an eminent domain
13	proceeding to acquire property, the board must:
14	(1) adopt a master development and redevelopment plan
15	for the property in or adjacent to the base property and incorporate
16	and approve the plan as part of the master plan of the municipality
17	in which the base property is located; and
18	(2) find, after conducting a public hearing, that:
19	(A) notice of the hearing was published in a
20	newspaper of general circulation in the municipality in which the
21	base property is located not later than the 15th day before the date
22	of the hearing;
23	(B) the property lies in a redevelopment project

- 2 (C) the use of eminent domain is necessary to
- 3 acquire the property to carry out the essential objectives of the
- 4 master development and redevelopment plan as approved by the
- 5 <u>municipality</u>.
- 6 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 7 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 8 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 9 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 10 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
