- 2 relating to certain records kept by the Department of Public Safety
- 3 involving the holder of a driver's license.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 521, Transportation Code,
- 6 is amended by adding Section 521.0475 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 521.0475. DISCLOSURE OF ABSTRACT RECORD. (a) Except
- 8 as provided by Subsection (b) or (c), the department shall provide a
- 9 certified abstract of a complete driving record of a license
- 10 holder, for a fee of \$20, to the license holder or a person eligible
- 11 to receive the information under Sections 730.007(a)(2)(A), (D),
- 12 and (I).
- (b) If an abstract of a complete driving record does not
- 14 exist for a license holder, the department shall provide a person
- 15 <u>making a request under Subsection (a) a certified state</u>ment to that
- 16 effect.
- 17 (c) If the department provides information under Subsection
- 18 (a) or (b) through the system described by Section 521.055, the
- 19 information may not be marked as certified.
- 20 SECTION 2. Section 521.052, Transportation Code, is amended
- 21 to read as follows:
- 22 Sec. 521.052. DISCLOSURE OF INDIVIDUAL INFORMATION
- 23 PROHIBITED. Except as provided by Sections 521.045, 521.046,
- 521.0475, 521.049(c), and 521.050[, and 601.022], and by Chapter

- 1 730, the department may not disclose information from the
- 2 department's files that relates to personal information, as that
- 3 term is defined by Section 730.003.
- 4 SECTION 3. Section 521.053, Transportation Code, is amended
- 5 by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsections (c) and (d) to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (a) The department may provide to any person the information
- 8 specified by Section 521.045, 521.046, 521.0475, or 521.047 [and by
- 9 Section 601.022], for the fee required by those sections, that
- 10 relate to the holder of or applicant for a commercial driver's
- 11 license under Chapter 522 if the person is eligible to receive the
- information under Chapter 730.
- 13 (c) The department may provide information under Subsection
- 14 (a) through the system described by Section 521.055.
- 15 <u>(d) The department may provide information maintained under</u>
- 16 <u>Section 643.064 that relates to a holder of a commercial driver's</u>
- 17 license under Chapter 522 to the holder, the holder's current
- 18 employer, or a person acting on behalf of the employer if the
- 19 department receives the holder's specific written consent to the
- 20 release of information.
- 21 SECTION 4. Sections 521.055(b) and (c), Transportation
- 22 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 23 (b) The system may provide for the release of <u>driving</u>
- 24 <u>records described in [the following information]:</u>
- 25 (1) [the status check described in] Section 521.045;
- 26 [and]
- 27 (2) [the three-year driving record under] Section

- 1 521.046<u>;</u>
- 2 (3) Section 521.047; and
- 3 <u>(4)</u> Section 521.0475.
- 4 (c) The fee for a driving record [status check] under
- 5 Subsection (b)(1) is \$2.50. The fee for a [three-year] driving
- 6 record under Subsection (b)(2) is \$4.50. The fee for a driving
- 7 record under Subsection (b)(3) is \$5.50. The fee for a driving
- 8 record under Subsection (b)(4) is \$20.
- 9 SECTION 5. Section 643.052, Transportation Code, is amended
- 10 to read as follows:
- 11 Sec. 643.052. APPLICATION. To register under this
- 12 subchapter a motor carrier must submit to the department an
- 13 application on a form prescribed by the department. The
- 14 application must include:
- 15 (1) the name of the owner and the principal business
- 16 address of the motor carrier;
- 17 (2) the name and address of the legal agent for service
- of process on the carrier in this state, if different;
- 19 (3) a description of each vehicle requiring
- 20 registration the carrier proposes to operate, including the motor
- 21 vehicle identification number, make, and unit number;
- 22 (4) a statement as to whether the carrier proposes to
- transport household goods or a hazardous material;
- 24 (5) a declaration that the applicant has knowledge of
- 25 all laws and rules relating to motor carrier safety, including this
- 26 chapter, Chapter 644, and Subtitle C; [and]
- 27 (6) a certification that the carrier is in compliance

- with the drug testing requirements of 49 C.F.R. Part 382, and if the
- 2 carrier belongs to a consortium, as defined by 49 C.F.R. Part 382,
- 3 the names of the persons operating the consortium; and
- 4 (7) any other information the department by rule
- 5 determines is necessary for the safe operation of a motor carrier
- 6 under this chapter.
- 7 SECTION 6. Section 643.056(a), Transportation Code, is
- 8 amended to read as follows:
- 9 (a) A motor carrier required to register under this
- 10 subchapter shall supplement the carrier's application for
- 11 registration before:
- 12 (1) the carrier transports a hazardous material or
- 13 household goods if the carrier has not provided notice of the
- 14 transportation to the department in the carrier's initial or a
- 15 supplemental application for registration;
- 16 (2) the carrier operates a vehicle requiring
- 17 registration that is not described on the carrier's initial or a
- 18 supplemental application for registration; or
- 19 (3) the carrier changes the carrier's principal
- 20 business address, legal agent, ownership, consortium, as defined by
- 21 <u>49 C.F.R. Part 382</u>, or name.
- SECTION 7. Subchapter B, Chapter 643, Transportation Code,
- is amended by adding Section 643.064 to read as follows:
- Sec. 643.064. REPORT OF POSITIVE RESULT. (a) A motor
- 25 carrier required to register under this chapter shall report to the
- 26 Department of Public Safety a valid positive result on a controlled
- 27 substances test performed as part of the carrier's drug testing

- 1 program or consortium, as defined by 49 C.F.R. Part 382, on an
- 2 employee of the carrier who holds a commercial driver's license
- 3 <u>under Chapter 522.</u>
- 4 (b) The Department of Public Safety shall maintain the
- 5 <u>information provided under this section.</u>
- 6 (c) Information maintained under this section is
- 7 confidential and only subject to release as provided by Section
- 8 <u>521.053.</u>
- 9 SECTION 8. Section 601.022, Transportation Code, is
- 10 repealed.
- 11 SECTION 9. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
