| 9 | junior college district may order an election on the question of |
| 10 | establishing expanded boundaries for the junior college district to |
| 11 | encompass all or part of the territory located within the |
| 12 | district's service area established by Subchapter J. |
| 13 | (b) The election shall be held in the combined territory of |
| 14 | the junior college district and any territory proposed to be added. |
| 15 | The order must: |
| 16 | (1) describe the entire territory proposed to be |
| 17 | included in the new boundaries of the district; and |
| 18 | (2) set a date for the election, which must be the next |
| 19 | uniform election date that is more than 45 days after the date of |
| 20 | the order. |
| 21 | (c) The ballot for the election shall be printed to provide |
| 22 | for voting for or against the proposition: "Establishing expanded |
| 23 | boundaries for the (with the blank filled in with |

| 4 | (d) The proposition is adopted if approved by a majority of |
| 5 | the votes cast at the election. |
| 6 | (e) If the proposition is adopted, the governing body of the |
| 7 | junior college district shall enter an order stating that the new |
| 8 | boundaries are established for the district for junior college |
| 9 | purposes. If the governing body is elected from single-member |
| 10 | districts, the governing body shall assign any new territory to one |
| 11 | or more of those single-member districts and make any other |
| 12 | appropriate changes to those districts in the order or in a |
| 13 | subsequent order before the next election for members of the |
| 14 | governing body. |
| 15 | (f) The addition of territory to a junior college district |
| 16 | under this section and any resulting change in the single-member |
| 17 | districts from which members of the governing body are elected does |
| 18 | not affect the term of a member of the governing body serving on the |
| 19 | date the addition or redistricting takes effect. |
| 20 | (g) A junior college district may not adopt new boundaries |
| 21 | for the district under this section that extend within the service |
| 22 | area of another junior college district. |
| 23 | (h) If the proposition to establish new boundaries for the |
| 24 | junior college district is not adopted at the election, another |
| 25 | election to extend the boundaries of the same junior college |
| 26 | district may not be held under this section earlier than the fifth |
| 27 | anniversary of the date of the election on the proposition. |

1 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 2 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 3 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 4 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 5 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
