1-7 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-8 AN ACT

1-9 relating to the development and implementation of a Texas music
1-10 compact disc project by the Texas Commission on the Arts.

1-11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-12 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 444, Government Code, is
1-13 amended by adding Section 444.032 to read as follows:

1-14 Sec. 444.032. TEXAS MUSIC PROJECT. (a) The commission
1-15 shall develop and implement a Texas music compact disc project
1-16 under which the commission shall create, promote, and distribute a
1-17 series of compact discs that feature the work of established and
1-18 emerging music artists of this state.

1-19 (b) The commission shall seek donations of time, talent, and
1-20 property from music artists and other persons to help facilitate
1-21 the project.

1-22 (c) All proceeds from the sale of compact discs under the
1-23 project shall be deposited in the Texas cultural endowment fund
1-24 under Section 444.026.

1-25 (d) In accordance with this chapter and commission policy,
1-26 the commission shall use part of the interest earned on the proceeds
1-27 of the project to fund grants of money that promote music education
1-28 through the commission's arts education grant program.

1-29 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-30 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-31 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-32 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-33 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
