## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the decentralization of certain state agencies and to
- 3 the location of the headquarters of certain state agencies.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. DEFINITION. In this Act, "state agency" means an
- 6 office, institution, or other agency that is in the executive
- 7 branch of state government, has authority that is not limited to a
- 8 geographical portion of the state, and was created by the
- 9 constitution or a statute of this state, but does not include an
- 10 institution of higher education as defined by Section 61.003,
- 11 Education Code.
- 12 SECTION 2. REVIEW. Not later than September 1, 2004, the
- 13 board or other governing body of a state agency shall conduct a
- 14 thorough review of the agency's organizational structure to
- 15 identify:
- 16 (1) programs, functions, and administration of the
- 17 agency that are unnecessarily or inappropriately consolidated in a
- 18 certain geographic area of the state;
- 19 (2) whether the state agency's headquarters is
- 20 unnecessarily or inappropriately located in the Austin area; and
- 21 (3) any specific barriers to:
- (A) decentralizing the agency's programs,
- 23 functions, and administration by distributing them throughout a
- 24 greater geographic portion of the state; or

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- 1 (B) moving the agency's headquarters from the
- 2 Austin area to a different geographic area of the state.
- 3 SECTION 3. RECOMMENDATIONS. Based on information
- 4 identified in a review under Section 2 of this Act, the board or
- 5 other governing body of a state agency shall, not later than October
- 6 1, 2004, develop specific recommendations regarding:
- 7 (1) whether the organizational structure of the agency
- 8 should be decentralized throughout a greater geographic portion of
- 9 the state; and
- 10 (2) whether the headquarters of the agency should be
- 11 moved from the Austin area to a different geographic area of the
- 12 state.
- SECTION 4. PLAN. Not later than December 1, 2004, if a
- decentralization or move is recommended under Section 3 of this Act
- 15 by the board or other governing body of a state agency, the state
- 16 agency shall develop an appropriate plan to:
- 17 (1) decentralize the organizational structure of the
- agency throughout a greater geographic portion of the state or move
- 19 the headquarters of the agency from the Austin area to a different
- 20 geographic area of the state; and
- 21 (2) modify the agency's programs, policies,
- 22 procedures, and administration as necessary to facilitate the
- 23 decentralization or move.
- SECTION 5. TRANSITION. Not later than January 1, 2005, a
- 25 state agency shall submit to the 79th Legislature a report
- 26 regarding the results of a review under Section 2 of this Act, any
- 27 recommendations issued under Section 3 of this Act, and any plan

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- 1 developed by the board or other governing body of the state agency
- 2 under Section 4 of this Act. A report must include the state
- 3 agency's recommendations for any statutory changes required to
- 4 facilitate a recommended decentralization or move or a modification
- of the agency's programs, policies, procedures, or administration
- 6 that is necessary to facilitate the recommended decentralization or
- 7 move.
- 8 SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE; EXPIRATION. (a) This Act takes
- 9 effect September 1, 2003.
- 10 (b) This Act expires September 1, 2005.
