- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 87, Civil Practice and Remedies Code, is 6 amended by adding Section 87.006 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 87.006. LANDOWNER DUTY WITH RESPECT TO CERTAIN EQUINE
- 8 ACTIVITIES. (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b), an owner or
- 9 possessor of land does not have a duty to warn a person who comes
- 10 onto the land for the purpose of riding an equine animal or a
- 11 conveyance drawn by an equine animal of hazardous conditions on the
- 12 land, uses of structures on the land, or activities on the land.
- (b) An owner or possessor of land who gives permission to a
- 14 person to come onto the land for a purpose described by Subsection
- 15 (a) has a duty to not wilfully or maliciously fail to guard or warn
- 16 against a hazardous condition of the land.
- 17 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 18 to a cause of action that accrues on or after the effective date of
- 19 this Act. A cause of action that accrues before the effective date
- 20 of this Act is governed by the law in effect immediately before the
- 21 effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for
- 22 that purpose.
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
