Sections 16.01(a) and (c), Alcoholic Beverage Code, are amended to read as follows: (a) The holder of a winery permit may: (1) manufacture, bottle, label, and package wine containing not more than 24 percent alcohol by volume; (2) manufacture and import grape brandy for fortifying purposes only and to be used only on his licensed premises; (3) sell wine in this state to permit holders <u>authorized to purchase and sell wine (holders of wholesaler's</u> <u>permits, winery permits, and wine bottler's permits</u>); (4) sell wine to ultimate consumers: (A) for consumption on the winery premises; or (E) in unbroken packages for off-premises consumption in an amount not to exceed <u>35,000</u> [25,000] gallons annually; (5) sell the wine outside this state to qualified persons; (6) blend wines; and (7) dispense free wine for consumption on the winery premises.
