- 5 SECTION 1. Section 258.001, Occupations Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 258.001. IMPERMISSIBLE DELEGATIONS. A dentist may not
- 8 delegate:
- 9 (1) an act to an individual who, by board order, is
- 10 prohibited from performing the act;
- 11 (2) any of the following acts to a person not licensed
- 12 as a dentist or dental hygienist:
- 13 (A) the removal of calculus, deposits, or
- 14 accretions from the natural and restored surfaces of exposed human
- 15 teeth and restorations in the human mouth;
- 16 (B) root planing or the smoothing and polishing
- of roughened root surfaces or exposed human teeth; or
- 18 (C) any other act the delegation of which is
- 19 prohibited by board rule;
- 20 (3) any of the following acts to a person not licensed
- 21 as a dentist:
- 22 (A) comprehensive examination or diagnosis and
- 23 treatment planning;
- 24 (B) a surgical or cutting procedure on hard or

- 1 soft tissue;
- 2 (C) the prescription of a drug, medication, or
- 3 work authorization;
- 4 (D) the taking of an impression for a final
- 5 restoration, appliance, or prosthesis;
- 6 (E) the making of an intraoral occlusal
- 7 adjustment;
- 8 (F) direct pulp capping, pulpotomy, or any other
- 9 endodontic procedure;
- 10 (G) the final placement and intraoral adjustment
- of a fixed or removable appliance; or
- 12 (H) the placement of any final restoration; [or]
- 13 (4) except as provided by Subdivision (5), the
- 14 authority to an individual to administer a local anesthetic agent,

- 25 (5) the authority to a dental hygienist to administer

Section 262.151(a), Occupations Code, is amended 3 to read as follows: A licensed dentist may delegate orally or in writing a 4 5 service, task, or procedure to a dental hygienist who is under the supervision and responsibility of the dentist, if: 6 7 the dental hygienist: (1)8 (A) is licensed to perform the service, task, or procedure; and 9 10 (B) holds any necessary certification issued by the board; 11 the supervising dentist examines the patient: 12 (2) at the time the service, task, or procedure 13 14 is performed by the dental hygienist; or 15 (B) during the 12 calendar months preceding the date of performance of the service, task, or procedure by the dental 16 hygienist; and 17 (3) the dental hygienist does not: 18 19 diagnose a dental disease or ailment; prescribe a treatment or a regimen; 20 (B) 21 prescribe, order, or dispense medication; or (C) perform any procedure that is irreversible or 22 (D)

- 1 AGENT. (a) The board by rule shall provide for issuance of a
- 2 certificate to a dental hygienist to administer a local anesthetic
- 3 agent.
- 4 (b) To obtain a certificate under this section, a dental
- 5 hygienist must meet the educational qualifications and provide
- 6 proof of competency in the administration of local anesthetic
- 7 agents as required by the board after consultation with the
- 8 advisory committee.
- 9 (c) Rules adopted by the board under this section must
- 10 <u>include</u> rules that regulate the administration of a local
- 11 anesthetic agent by a dental hygienist who holds a certificate
- 12 under this section, including rules that provide for supervision of
- 13 the dental hygienist by a dentist or physician licensed in this
- 14 state.
- 15 SECTION 4. (a) This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
- 16 (b) The State Board of Dental Examiners shall adopt rules
- 17 required by Section 262.154, Occupations Code, as added by this
- 18 Act, not later than January 1, 2004.
