- 2 relating to the rights of certain victims of violent crimes and
- 3 relatives or guardians of the victims.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 56, Code of Criminal
- 6 Procedure, is amended by adding Article 56.021 to read as follows:
- 7 Art. 56.021. DISCRIMINATION ON BASIS OF OFFENSE PROHIBITED.
- 8 Each right guaranteed to a victim, close relative of a deceased
- 9 victim, or guardian of a victim by the Texas Constitution or other
- 10 law must be available to all victims, relatives, and guardians on an
- 11 equal basis. Notwithstanding any law relating to capital
- 12 punishment, a victim, relative, or guardian may not be
- 13 <u>discriminated against and the rights of the victim, relative, or</u>
- 14 guardian may not be denied, diminished, or enlarged on the basis of
- 15 the victim's, relative's, or guardian's support for, neutrality on,
- or opposition to the death penalty, either as a general proposition
- or as punishment in a particular criminal prosecution.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
