4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Art. 3.50-7. Texas School Employees Uniform Group Health Coverage Act, Section 9. Payment of Contributions for

7 Program, Subsections (a) and (b) are amended to read as follows:

- (a) The state shall assist employees of participating school districts and charter schools in the purchase of group health coverage under this article by [providing for each covered employee the amount of \$900 each state fiscal year or a greater amount as provided by the General Appropriations Act.] paying each fiscal year the full cost of employee only coverage and fifty percent (50%) of any dependent coverage selected, for each covered employee. The state cost shall be reduced by the amount of the participating entity contribution as provided by Article 3.50-9 of this code. The state contribution shall be distributed through the school finance formulas under Chapters 41 and 42, Education Code,
 - (b) The state shall assist employees of participating regional education service centers and educational districts described by Section 2(6)(B) of this article in the purchase of group health coverage under this article by providing to the employing service center or educational district, for each covered

- [(2) if the following amount is less than the amount specified by Subdivision (1), the sum of:
- [(A) the amount determined by multiplying the
 amount of \$900 or the amount specified in the General

 contribution under Section 9, Article 3.50-7, Insurance Code, by
 the number of district or school employees who participate in a

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- group health coverage plan provided by or through the district or school; and

 [(B) the difference between the amount necessary for the district or school to comply with Section 3, Article 3.50-9,

 Insurance Code, for that school year and the amount the district or school is required to use to provide health coverage under Section 2
