- 2 relating to liens on stored hydrocarbons at sites and facilities
- 3 that have not been timely cleaned up.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 91.115, Natural Resources
- 6 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 91.115. FIRST LIEN ON EQUIPMENT AND STORED
- 8 HYDROCARBONS.
- 9 SECTION 2. Section 91.115, Natural Resources Code, is
- 10 amended by amending Subsections (a), (e), and (f) and adding
- 11 Subsection (h) to read as follows:
- 12 (a) If a responsible person fails to clean up a site or
- 13 facility that has ceased oil and gas operations under the
- 14 commission's jurisdiction on or before the date the site or
- 15 facility is required to be cleaned up by law or by a rule adopted or
- order issued by the commission, the state has a first lien, superior
- 17 to all preexisting and subsequent liens and security interests, on
- 18 the responsible person's interest in any hydrocarbons stored at the
- 19 site or facility and in any equipment that is:
- 20 (1) located at the site or facility; and
- 21 (2) used by the responsible person in connection with
- 22 the activity that generated the pollution.
- (e) The lien is extinguished as to any stored hydrocarbons
- or items [item] of equipment that are [is] lawfully removed by any

- 1 person other than the operator or a nonoperator according to a lien,
- lease, judgment, written contract, or security agreement before the
- 3 commission enters into a cleanup contract. An item of equipment may
- 4 not be removed from an abandoned site or facility if the removal
- 5 will cause the release of a substance that may cause pollution
- 6 unless the substance is lawfully disposed of.
- 7 (f) Equipment or stored hydrocarbons subject to a lien under
- 8 this section  $\underline{\text{are}}$  [ $\underline{\text{is}}$ ] presumed to have been abandoned on the date
- 9 the commission enters into a contract to clean up the site or
- 10 facility on which the equipment or hydrocarbons are [is] located.
- 11 The commission may dispose of the equipment or stored hydrocarbons
- in accordance with the provisions of Sections 89.085, 89.086, and
- 13 89.087 of this code for the disposition of well-site equipment and
- 14 hydrocarbons.
- (h) The lien provided by this section, as it relates to
- stored hydrocarbons, shall be subject to and inferior to any lien in
- 17 favor of the State of Texas to secure royalty payments.
- SECTION 3. (a) This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
- 19 (b) The changes in law made by Section 91.115, Natural
- 20 Resources Code, as amended by this Act, apply only to an interest in
- 21 hydrocarbons stored at a site or facility the date for cleanup of
- 22 which required by law or rule or order adopted by the Railroad
- 23 Commission of Texas is September 1, 2003, or later.
