## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT 2 relating to the reimbursement of expenses in ratemaking 3 proceedings. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 33.023, Utilities Code, is amended to 5 6 read as follows: Sec. 33.023. RATEMAKING PROCEEDINGS. 7 (a) The governing body of a municipality participating in or conducting a ratemaking 8 9 proceeding may engage rate consultants, accountants, auditors, attorneys, and engineers to: 10 conduct investigations, present evidence, 11 (1)and 12 advise and represent the governing body; and 13 (2) assist the governing body with litigation in [an 14 electric utility] ratemaking proceeding for the electric utility or the affiliated retail electric provider before the governing body, 15 a regulatory authority, or a court. 16 (b) The electric utility or the affiliated retail electric 17 18 provider in the ratemaking proceeding shall reimburse the governing body of the municipality for the reasonable cost of the services of 19 a person engaged under Subsection (a) to the extent the applicable 20 21 regulatory authority determines is reasonable. 22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all members elected to each house, as 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. 24 If this

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1 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

2 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
