- 6 SECTION 1. Section 101.004, Election Code, is amended by
- 7 amending Subsection (j) and adding Subsection (k) to read as
- 8 follows:
- 9 (j) If the early voting clerk determines that an application
- 10 that is submitted before the time prescribed by Subsection (e)(1)
- 11 does not contain the information that is required for registration
- 12 under Title 2, the clerk shall notify the applicant of that fact.
- 13 If the applicant has provided a telephone number or an address for
- 14 receiving mail over the Internet, the clerk shall notify the
- 15 applicant by that medium.
- 16 (k) If the applicant submits the missing information before
- 17 the time prescribed by Subsection (e)(1), the applicant is entitled
- 18 to receive a full ballot to be voted by mail under this chapter. If
- 19 the applicant submits the missing information after the time
- 20 prescribed by Subsection (e)(1), the applicant is entitled to
- 21 receive a full ballot to be voted by mail for the next election that
- 22 occurs:
- 23 (1) in the same calendar year; and
- 24 (2) at least 30 days after the date the information is
