- Sec. 21.4031. LIMIT ON ADMINISTRATOR COMPENSATION. A

  8 school district may not pay an administrator compensation that

  9 exceeds five times the lowest amount of compensation the district

  10 pays a classroom teacher.
- SECTION 2. Subchapter D, Chapter 42, Education Code, is amended by adding Section 42.202 to read as follows:
- Sec. 42.202. LIMIT ON ADMINISTRATOR EMPLOYMENT. (a) A

  school district may not employ a number of administrators that

  exceeds a ratio of one administrator for each 12 teachers employed

  by the district.
- 17 (a-1) Notwithstanding Subsection (a), for the 2003-2004,

  18 2004-2005, and 2005-2006 school years, a school district may not

  19 employ a number of administrators that exceeds a ratio of one

  20 administrator for each 11 teachers employed by the district. This

  21 subsection expires September 1, 2007.
- 22 (b) For purposes of this section:
- 23 (1) an administrator who teaches one or more classes
  24 is counted as one-half an administrator and is not counted as a

- 1 <u>teacher; and</u>
- 2 (2) a counselor or librarian is not counted as either a
- 3 <u>teacher or an administrator.</u>
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act applies beginning with the 2003-2004
- 5 school year.
- 6 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 7 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 8 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 9 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 10 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
