A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the composition of the board of trustees of the Teacher
- 3 Retirement System of Texas.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 821.001(5), Government Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (5) "Board of trustees" means the <u>persons</u> [board]
- 8 appointed or elected under this subtitle to administer the
- 9 retirement system.
- 10 SECTION 2. Section 825.002, Government Code, is amended to
- 11 read as follows:
- 12 Sec. 825.002. APPOINTMENT AND ELECTION OF TRUSTEES
- 13 [APPOINTED BY COVERNOR]. (a) The governor shall appoint, with the
- 14 advice and consent of the senate [and as provided by this section],
- 15 [seven members of the board of trustees.
- 16 [(b) The governor shall appoint] three <u>trustees</u> [members]
- of the board of trustees to hold office for staggered terms, with
- 18 the term of one trustee expiring on August 31 of each odd-numbered
- 19 year. These <u>trustees</u> [members] must be persons who have
- 20 demonstrated financial expertise, who have worked in private
- 21 business or industry, and who have broad investment experience,
- 22 preferably in investment of pension funds. None of the trustees
- 23 [members] appointed under this subsection may be a member or
- 24 annuitant of the retirement system.

(b) Two trustees who are [(c) The governor shall appoint two members of the board from a slate of three] members of the retirement system and who are currently employed by a public school district shall be elected [and who have been nominated in accordance with Subsection (f)] by the members of the retirement system whose most recent credited service was performed for a public school district. The two trustees [members] hold office for staggered terms.

- (c) One trustee who is a [(d) The governor shall appoint one member of the board from a slate of three] former member [members] of the retirement system, has [who have] retired, and is [are] receiving benefits from the retirement system shall be elected [and who have been nominated in accordance with Subsections (f) and (g)] by [the] persons who have retired and are receiving benefits from the retirement system.
 - (d) One trustee who is a member [(e) The governor shall appoint one member from a slate of three members] of the retirement system and who is [are currently] employed by an institution of higher education shall be elected [and who have been nominated in accordance with Subsection (f)] by the members of the retirement system whose most recent credited service was performed for an institution of higher education.
 - (e) The board of trustees shall adopt rules for the election of trustees described [(f) Persons considered for nomination] under Subsection (b), (c), or (d)[, or (e) must have been nominated by written ballot at an election conducted under rules adopted by the board of trustees].

- 2 persons for appointment] under Subsection (c) [(d)], the board of
- 3 trustees shall send to each retiree of the retirement system:
- 4 (1) notice of the deadline for filing as a candidate
- 5 for election [nomination];
- 6 (2) information on procedures to follow in filing as a
- 7 candidate; and
- 8 (3) a [written] ballot.
- 9 SECTION 3. Sections 825.0032(a) and (b), Government Code,
- 10 are amended to read as follows:
- 11 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b), a person is not
- 12 eligible for appointment or election to the board of trustees if the
- 13 person or the person's spouse:
- 14 (1) is employed by or participates in the management
- of a business entity or other organization receiving funds from the
- 16 retirement system;
- 17 (2) owns or controls, directly or indirectly, more
- 18 than a 10 percent interest in a business entity or other
- organization receiving funds from the retirement system; or
- 20 (3) uses or receives a substantial amount of tangible
- 21 goods, services, or funds from the retirement system, other than
- 22 compensation or reimbursement authorized by law for board $\underline{\text{of}}$
- trustees membership, attendance, or expenses.
- (b) Subsection (a) does not apply to employment by,
- 25 participation in the management of, or ownership or control of an
- 26 interest in a business entity or other organization on behalf of the
- 27 retirement system. Subsection (a)(3) does not apply to a person who

- 1 is <u>elected</u> [nominated for appointment] under Section 825.002(b)
- [825.002(c)], (c), or (d)[$\frac{1}{7}$ or (e)].
- 3 SECTION 4. Section 825.0041(b), Government Code, is amended
- 4 to read as follows:
- 5 (b) A training program established under this section shall
- 6 provide information to the trustee [member] regarding:
- 7 (1) the enabling legislation that created the
- 8 retirement system and its policy-making body on [to] which the
- 9 trustee [member] is [appointed] to serve;
- 10 (2) the programs operated by the <u>retirement</u> system;
- 11 (3) the role and functions of the retirement system;
- 12 (4) the rules of the retirement system with an
- emphasis on the rules that relate to disciplinary and investigatory
- 14 authority;
- 15 (5) the current budget for the <u>retirement</u> system;
- 16 (6) the results of the most recent formal audit of the
- 17 retirement system;
- 18 (7) the requirements of the:
- 19 (A) open meetings law, Chapter 551;
- 20 (B) open records law, Chapter 552; and
- 21 (C) administrative procedure law, Chapter 2001;
- 22 (8) the requirements of the conflict of interest laws
- 23 and other laws relating to public officials; and
- 24 (9) any applicable ethics policies adopted by the
- 25 retirement system or the Texas Ethics Commission.
- SECTION 5. Section 825.009(a), Government Code, is amended
- 27 to read as follows:

- 1 (a) A trustee <u>elected</u> [appointed from a slate of members
 2 <u>nominated</u>] by members of the retirement system under Section
 3 825.002 is entitled to leave with pay from the trustee's public
 4 school employer to attend to the official business of the
 5 retirement system.
- SECTION 6. Sections 825.010(a) and (c), Government Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 8 (a) It is a ground for removal from the board <u>of trustees</u> if 9 a trustee:
- 10 (1) does not have at the time of appointment <u>or</u>
 11 election the qualifications required for the trustee's position;
- 12 (2) does not maintain during service on the board of
 13 trustees the qualifications required for the trustee's position;
- 14 (3) violates a prohibition established by Section 15 825.002(a) [825.002(b)] or 825.0032 applicable to the trustee;
- 16 (4) cannot because of illness or disability discharge 17 the trustee's duties for a substantial part of the term for which 18 the trustee is appointed <u>or elected</u>; or
- 19 (5) is absent from more than one-third of the 20 regularly scheduled board of trustees meetings that the person is 21 eligible to attend during a calendar year unless the absence is 22 excused by majority vote of the board of trustees.
- (c) If the executive director has knowledge that a potential ground for removal exists, the executive director shall notify the presiding officer of the board of trustees of the ground. The presiding officer shall then notify the governor [appropriate appointing officer] and the attorney general that a potential

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- 1 ground for removal exists. If the potential ground for removal
- 2 involves the presiding officer, the executive director shall notify
- 3 the next highest officer of the board of trustees, who shall notify
- 4 the <u>governor</u> [appropriate appointing officer] and the attorney
- 5 general that a potential ground for removal exists.
- 6 SECTION 7. (a) This Act takes effect January 1, 2004, and
- 7 applies only to the appointment or election of a trustee of the
- 8 board of trustees of the Teacher Retirement System of Texas that
- 9 occurs on or after that date.
- 10 (b) A person who is serving as a trustee immediately before
- 11 the effective date of this Act may complete the trustee's term of
- office, and the trustee's qualifications for serving as a trustee
- 13 are governed by the law in effect immediately before the effective
- 14 date of this Act until the date that trustee's term expires.
