4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 11.1271, Water Code, is amended by

amending Subsection (c) and adding Subsections (d), (e), and (f) to

- 8 (c) <u>Beginning May 1, 2005, all water conservation plans</u>
- 9 required under this section must include specific, quantified
- 10 <u>5-year and 10-year targets for water savings.</u> The entity preparing
- 11 the plan shall establish the targets. Targets must include goals
- for water loss programs and goals for municipal use in gallons per
- 13 capita per day.
- 14 (d) The commission and the board jointly shall identify
- 15 quantified target goals for water conservation that water suppliers
- 16 and other entities may use as guidelines in preparing water
- 17 conservation plans. Goals established under this subsection are
- 18 not enforceable requirements.
- 19 (e) The commission and board jointly shall develop model
- 20 water conservation programs for different types of water suppliers
- 21 that suggest best management practices for achieving the highest

- 9 SECTION 6. Not later than September 1, 2004, the Texas
- 10 Commission on Environmental Quality and the Texas Water Development
- 11 Board shall take the actions necessary to comply with Section
- 12 11.1271, Water Code, as amended by this Act.
- 13 SECTION 7. (a) This Act takes effect immediately if it
- 14 receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each
- 15 house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution.
- 16 If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate
- effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
- 18 (b) The change in law made by this Act to Section 11.1271,
- 19 Water Code, applies to a holder of an existing permit, certified
- 20 filing, or certificate of adjudication as described in Section
- 21 11.1271(b), Water Code, regardless of whether the permit, certified
- 22 filing, or certificate of adjudication is obtained before, on, or
- 23 after that date.
- (c) The changes in law made by this Act to Sections 15.106,
- 25 17.125, 17.277, and 17.857, Water Code, apply only to applications
- 26 for financial assistance filed with the Texas Water Development
- 27 Board on or after the effective date of this Act.
