1	AN ACT
2	relating to zoning regulations applicable to places of historical,
3	cultural or architectural significance.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Title 7, ZONING REGULATIONS GENERALLY, Section
6	211.003, Local Government Code, is amended to read as follows:
7	(a) The governing body of a municipality may regulate:

- 8 (1) the height, number of stories, and size of
- 9 buildings and other structures;
- 10 (2) the percentage of a lot that may be occupied;
- 11 (3) the size of yards, courts, and other open spaces;
- 12 (4) population density; and
- 13 (5) the location and use of buildings, other
- 14 structures, and land for business, industrial, residential, or
- 15 other purposes.
- 16 (b) In the case of designated places and areas of
- 17 historical, cultural, or architectural importance and
- 18 significance, the governing body of a municipality may regulate the
- 19 construction, reconstruction, alteration, or razing of buildings
- 20 and other structures <u>except for property subject to a tax exemption</u>
- 21 pursuant to Section 11.20, Tax Code.
- (c) The governing body of a home-rule municipality may also
- 23 regulate the bulk of buildings.
- 24 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

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- 1 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 2 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 3 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 4 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
