- 2 relating to accreditation of public school districts.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- SECTION 1. Section 39.073, Texas Education Code, is amended by adding a new subsection (g) to read as follows:
- 6 (g) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the
- 7 performance on any academic excellence indicators of students who
- 8 are confined by court order in a residential program or facility
- 9 operated by, or under a contract with, the Texas Youth Commission or
- 10 other governmental entity shall not be considered in determining
- the accreditation status of the district within which such program
- or facility is physically located, nor in determining the
 district's performance in relation to the standards adopted for
- 14 each academic excellence indicator. The performance of such
- 15 students on any assessment instrument or other academic excellence
- indicators adopted by the state shall be determined and reported
- 17 separately from the determination and report of the district within
- 18 which the program or facility is physically located.
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2003-2004
- 20 school year.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
