- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 663.001(1), Transportation Code, is
- 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 (1) "All-terrain vehicle" means a motor vehicle that
- 7 is:
- 8 (A) equipped with a saddle for the use of:
- 9 <u>(i)</u> the rider; and
- 10 <u>(ii) a passenger, if the motor vehicle is</u>
- 11 designed by the manufacturer to transport a passenger;
- 12 (B) designed to propel itself with three or four
- 13 tires in contact with the ground;
- 14 (C) designed by the manufacturer for off-highway
- 15 use by the operator only; and
- 16 (D) not designed by the manufacturer for farming
- 17 or lawn care.
- SECTION 2. Section 663.036, Transportation Code, is amended
- 19 to read as follows:
- Sec. 663.036. CARRYING PASSENGERS [PROHIBITED]. A person
- 21 may not carry a passenger on an all-terrain vehicle operated on
- 22 public property unless the all-terrain vehicle is designed by the
- 23 <u>manufacturer to transport a passenger</u>.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
