H.B. No. 2694

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to fraud awareness training for employees of state
3 agencies.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 321.013, Government Code, is amended by
6 adding Subsection (j) to read as follows:

7 (j) The State Auditor shall develop fraud awareness
8 training programs for use by state agencies.

9 SECTION 2. Subchapter C, Chapter 656, Government Code, is
10 amended by adding Section 656.050 to read as follows:

11 Sec. 656.050. FRAUD AWARENESS TRAINING. A state agency
12 shall provide fraud awareness training to all employees by
13 implementing fraud awareness training programs developed by the
14 state auditor.

15 SECTION 3. Not later than June 1, 2004, the state auditor
16 shall develop fraud awareness training programs for use by state
17 agencies, as required by Section 321.013(j), Government Code, as
18 added by this Act.

19 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
23 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
