- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 321.013, Government Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subsection (j) to read as follows:
- 7 <u>(j)</u> The State Auditor shall develop fraud awareness
- 8 training programs for use by state agencies.
- 9 SECTION 2. Subchapter C, Chapter 656, Government Code, is
- amended by adding Section 656.050 to read as follows:
- Sec. 656.050. FRAUD AWARENESS TRAINING. A state agency
- 12 shall provide fraud awareness training to all employees by
- 13 <u>implementing fraud awareness training programs developed by the</u>
- 14 state auditor.
- SECTION 3. Not later than June 1, 2004, the state auditor
- 16 shall develop fraud awareness training programs for use by state
- 17 agencies, as required by Section 321.013(j), Government Code, as
- 18 added by this Act.
- 19 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
