- [(c) Notwithstanding any other provision of this section,
  an individual who has been paid benefits in the individual's
  current benefit year equal to or exceeding three times the
  individual's benefit amount is eligible to receive benefits on the
  individual's waiting period claim in accordance with this
  subtitle.
- 9 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003, and applies only to a claim for unemployment compensation benefits that is filed with the Texas Workforce Commission on or after that date. A claim filed before that date is governed by the law in effect on the date that the claim was filed, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
