The commission panel shall personally 16 deliver or mail that copy promptly after the decision becomes 17 In addition, an abbreviated copy of the order shall be 18 final. published one time in a newspaper of general circulation in the 19 municipality within 10 calendar days after the date of the delivery 20 21 or mailing of the copy as provided by this subsection, including the 22 street address or legal description of the property; the date of 23 the hearing, a brief statement indicating the results of the order, and instructions stating where a complete copy of the order may be 24

No. 2732 obtained, and, except in a municipality with a population of 1.9 1 2 million or more, a copy shall be filed in the office of the municipal secretary or clerk. 3 4 SECTION 2. Section 214.001(f), Local Government Code, is 5 amended to read as follows: 6 (f) Within 10 days after the date that the order is issued, 7 the municipality shall: (1) file a copy of the order in the office of the 8 municipal secretary or clerk, if the municipality has a population 9 of 1.9 million or less; and 10 (2) publish in a newspaper of general circulation in 11 the municipality in which the building is located a notice 12 13 containing: 14 (A) the street address or legal description of 15 the property; 16 (B) the date of the hearing; 17 (C) a brief statement indicating the results of the order; and 18 instructions stating where a complete copy of 19 (D) the order may be obtained. 20 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003. 21
