- 10 person to pay an amount not to exceed \$500 in one payment or in
- 11 periodic installments, as considered appropriate by the judge, to a
- 12 trauma facility owned or operated by a political subdivision of
- 13 <u>this state.</u>
- SECTION 2. (a) This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
- 15 (b) The change in law made by this Act applies only to an
- offense committed before the effective date of this Act is covered
