## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the release on bond of certain persons arrested without

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Article 17.033, Code of Criminal Procedure, is
- 6 amended by adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:
- 7 (d) The time limits imposed by Subsections (a) and (b) do
- 8 not apply to a person arrested without a warrant who is taken to a
- 9 hospital, clinic, or other medical facility before being taken
- 10 before a magistrate under Article 15.17. For a person described by
- 11 this subsection, the time limits imposed by Subsections (a) and (b)
- 12 begin to run at the time that, following the person's release from a
- 13 hospital, clinic, or other medical facility, the person is taken
- 14 before a magistrate and the magistrate completes the performance of
- the magistrate's duties imposed by Article 15.17.
- 16 SECTION 2. (a) This Act takes effect immediately if it
- 17 receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each
- 18 house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution.
- 19 If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate
- 20 effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
- 21 (b) The change in law made by this Act applies only to an
- 22 arrest made on or after the effective date of this Act, regardless
- of when the offense giving rise to the arrest was committed. An
- 24 arrest made before the effective date of this Act is covered by the
